Apprentice Directors will:

- Attend design and production meetings as available
- Participate in a pre-rehearsal training intensive April 7, 8, 9. Additional honorarium provided for attending.
- > Attend rehearsals, technical rehearsals, previews and opening night for one of Bard's 2020 season productions
- Support the Director of the production as needed
- Receive mentorship from senior members of the Bard company
- > Receive an honorarium of \$2500

Bard will provide one return trip if you are not locally based. There are no additional funds for accommodation.

Candidates should have **completed** post-secondary training/education and have experience in the professional theatre.

Applications must include:

- A video statement of no more than 1 minute in length. Please introduce yourself and tell us why this opportunity is right for you and why now
- In 250 to 350 words please tell us about your interest in and experience with Shakespeare
- Your professional resumé (including education and/or training)
- Names and contact information for two professional references. (Letters of recommendation are **not** requested)
