

2021 HEALTH & SAFETY MEASURES

Created in compliance with WorkSafe BC and BC Camps Association Guidelines. Last Updated on May 27, 2021.

CLEANING MEASURES

- The camp space will be cleaned and disinfected at the end of each day, including the following:
 - Resources/Equipment
 - All surfaces (table tops, chairs, counters etc.)
 - Admin and workshop spaces
- Hand-sanitizing station installed inside and outside the studio to encourage routine sanitizing will be required of all participants and staff
- Washrooms will be disinfected daily, and cleaned regularly

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Capacity Limits and Flow

- Decreased capacity for in-person camps/workshops
- Signage around BMO Theatre Centre to remind participants/staff of capacity limits
- Floor markers to indicate direction of flow and boundaries

Drop-off/Pick-Up

- Only participants and staff are permitted inside the BMO Theatre Centre
- A staff member will help direct students to the studio following outdoor drop-off and completion of Health Declaration (see below)
- Physical barriers around small admin area within studio will be installed
- Masks will be required at all times, and relief from mask-wearing will be permitted outdoors during break
- Washrooms will be available for exclusive use of Education staff and participants
- Participants will only be permitted within the boundaries of the Education Area during their camp.

 Other rooms and corridors in the BMO Theatre Centre will be off-limits.

DAILY HEALTH CHECKS

- Health Check Declaration Waivers and Compliance Forms are completed each day before entering the building by:
 - All Bard Education Staff
 - All program participants (to be completed with a parent/guardian)
- Waivers acknowledge that staff/participants/family members show no symptoms of cold, flu, or COVID-19, have not travelled outside the country in the last 14 days, or been in close contact of someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19.
